

Appointment Procedures for NFA Positions

The following National Council Positions are appointed by the President with approval from the National Council

- National Tournament Director (3 year term)
- Editor for the National Forensics Journal (unlimited term) (re-evaluation after 3 years)

By **February 15**, an open interest call for upcoming positions will be sent to the membership schools via the following outlets: the email on file for each school, the NFA Website and all NFA social media sites.

Notification of interest is due to the NFA President by **March 1** via email. No notification of interest will be accepted for persons representing a school which has a continuing elected member currently in office. Interested parties are asked to submit a one-page letter of interest which includes a platform.

The NFA President will select a recommendation from the letters of interest and share the recommendation with the council for approval by **March 15**. The council must either approve the recommendation or request an alternative recommendation from those who provided letters of interest. Appointment decisions must be made by **March 25**.

Announcement of appointments will be announced on the NFA website by **April 1**.
